The Japanese side explained the progress of the JCM model and demonstration projects in FY 2013-2015 and benefit of the JCM demonstration program.

#### **Agenda item 8.1. Current status of the large scale JCM FS in Surabaya in collaboration with Kitakyushu City**

A representative from Kitakyushu City gave a presentation on its large scale JCM feasibility study in Surabaya. The JC welcomed the work done by both cities and encouraged further development of the project.

#### **Agenda item 8.2. COP 21**

The Indonesian side introduced an audio visual presentation on the development of the JCM in Indonesia and announced that it will show the presentation at the Indonesian Pavilion in the conference centre of Paris-Le Bourget during COP21.

The Japanese side introduced the draft agenda of the 3<sup>rd</sup> JCM Partner Countries’ High-level Meeting which is scheduled on 8 December 2015 at the Japan Pavilion located in the conference centre of the Paris-Le Bourget site during COP21.
